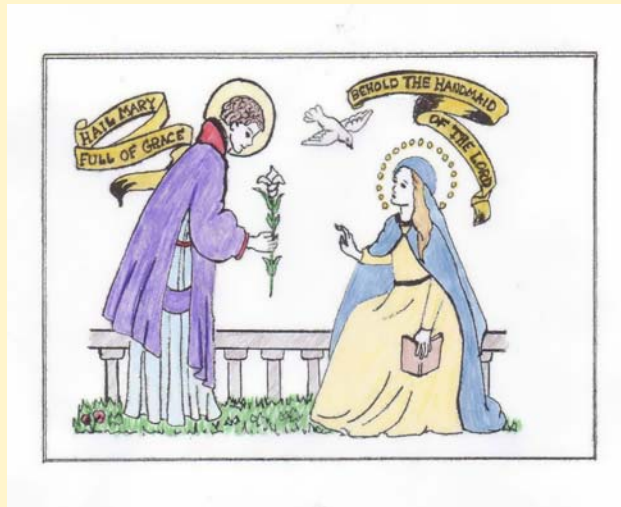

WELCOME OTHERS AS CHRIST HAS WELCOMED YOU

Last month we had a special presentation at Adult Forum on the theology of hospitality. Welcoming people into worship and fellowship in the parish is not just good manners it is an action grounded in theology and discipleship. The scriptures don't just suggest that we offer hospitality they demand it.

It is helpful to remember that the Church property is the shared home of all the members. This means that each of us is responsible for treating guests at St. Mary's the same way we would treat them in our own homes. This applies to the areas of the property used for worship as well as the areas used for fellowship. From a theological perspective it is helpful to entertain the idea that every person who decides to come to St. Mary's has been sent by God. God has moved them in some way to choose us instead of somewhere else. If God has sent us guests who are we not to receive them?

One of the weaknesses of this parish is that many of us do not know each other's names. If we were a parish of 500 that might be understandable. Being a parish of 150 it is not acceptable. We can change that. Starting in June there will be a station in the narthex and one in the foyer with simple peel off labels and a marker. Each time you come to Church please stop and make yourself a nametag. God knows each of us by name, we sometime need help.
